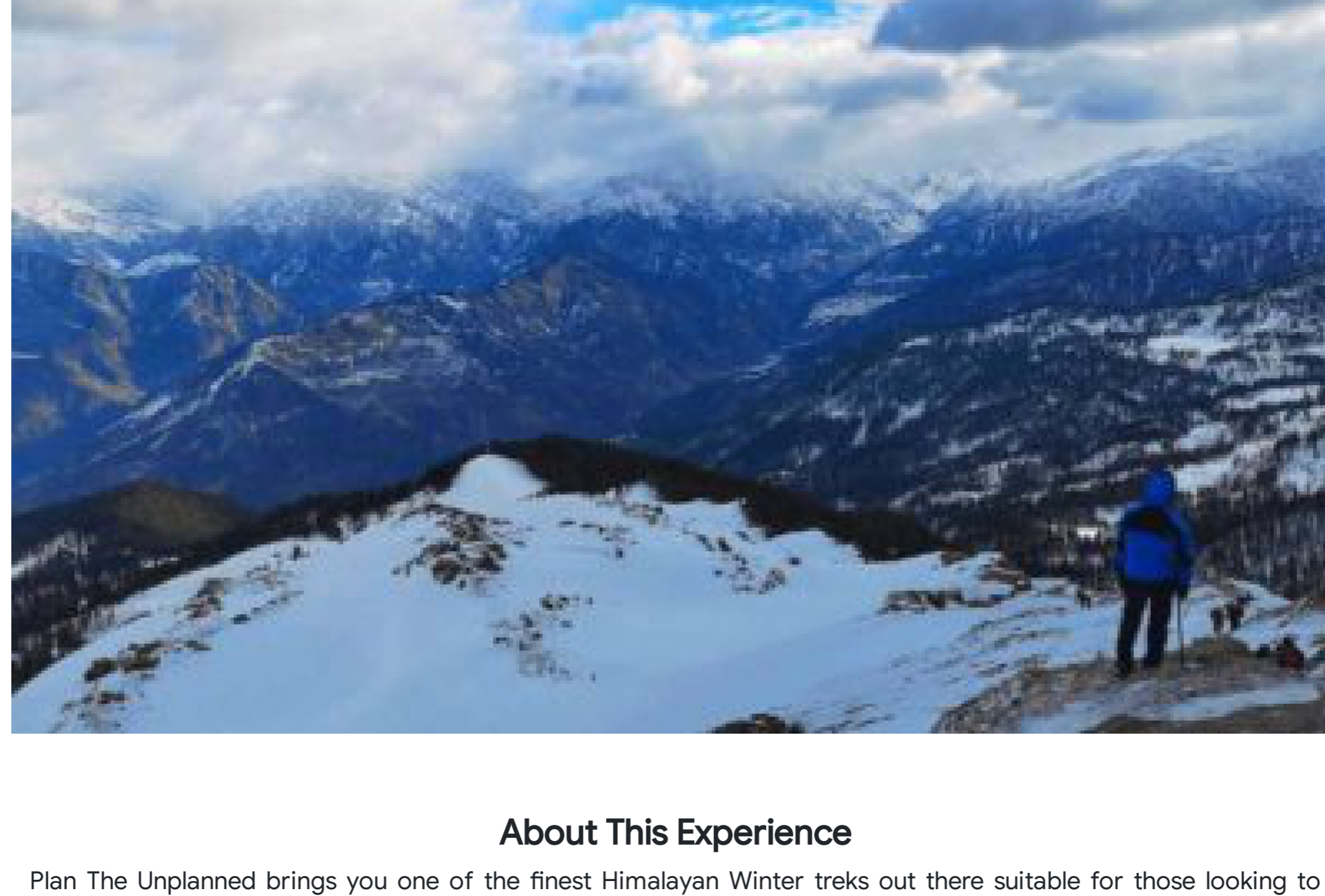




# Kedarkantha Trek

Trekkers can enjoy the Snowy campsites and also fresh snowfall during the winters. And the feeling of summiting a peak is unparalleled which also makes it very adventurous.

- >Any expenses for medical treatment of injury or accident before, during, or after the trek.

All Meals

- Day 1: Drive from Dehradun and Arrival at Sankri
- Day 2: Trek from Sankri to Juda Ka Taal (9050 Feet, 4 Kms)
- Day 3: Juda Ka Taal – Kedarkantha Base Camp (11200 ft, 4 Kms Trek)
- Day 4: Kedarkantha Base Camp- Kedarkantha (12,500 ft)-Hargaon Base Camp (8900ft)
- Day 5: Hargaon Camp – Sankri
- Day 6: Sankri – Dehradun

## THINGS TO CARRY

### Basic Essentials

- Day Bag(20-30 liter) with Rain Cover (If you hire mule or porter)
- Backpack(50-60 liter) with Rain Cover
- 2- water bottles
- Personal Medical kit (If you required)
- Hiking Shoes-water proof and ankle support
- Torch With extra batteries
- Original ID Card
- Glucose, Chocolates, biscuits, and nuts

### Clothing Essentials

- Thermal Wear
- 2-jacket (1 Fleece, 1 Down feather)
- Warm Inner-wear
- 2-Gloves (1 Woollen, 1 Waterproof)
- 2-Trek Pants (which is a comfortable full day)
- 4-T-shirts (2 Full Sleeves, 2 Half Sleeves)
- 2-Sweaters (1 Fleece, 1 Woollen)
- 5-Socks (3 Cotton, 2 Woollen)
- Rain Coat / Poncho
- Handkerchief/towels

### Protect Your Head

- 2- Caps (1 Sun Cap, 1 Woollen Cap)
- UV sunglass
- Balaclava

## FAQs

1. What will be the group size for Kedarkantha Trek ?

Usually, we take a maximum of 12 - 15 people in one group. We believe bigger groups have less fun and less coordination so that's why we prefer smaller groups.

We need at least 6 people to operate our fixed departure tours/treks.

2. I am the only girl in the group, is it safe to travel/trek solo?

Yes definitely it is, the safety of girls is most important for us. All our guides and other staff are carefully chosen for trips/treks. They are honest and reliable but we also advise you to take care of your personal belongings.

3. What are the washroom/toilet facilities like on the trek?

During the treks, separate toilet tents will be set up on each campsite.

4. What type of food is served during the trek?

We provide nutritious and healthy food during the treks. We always serve Indian vegetarian food and eggs.

### Cancellation Policy:

Here's the cancellation policy for Himalayan Treks/Backpacking Trips/Road Trips

- If you cancel before 30 days – 90% of amount will be refunded
- If you cancel between 20 -30 days – 75% % of amount will be refunded
- If you cancel between 15-19 days – 50% will be refunded
- If you cancel between 7-14 days – 25 % amount will be refunded
- If you cancel between 0- 7 days before the departure date – No amount would be refunded.

### Our Story : Plan The Unplanned

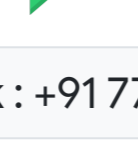
What's life without adventure? Isn't the real purpose of life to travel, to experience new places, and witness the sunrise from new mountaintops?

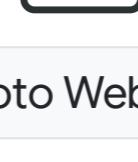

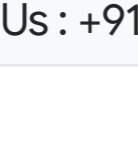
